

## **RHIS 66<sup>th</sup> Annual Scientific Meeting Video Abstract Presentations**

### **CME Session Goals:**

- Use critical analysis and listening skills to critique the research presentations and the resident and fellows' presentation skills.

### **Instructions:**

1. Review each of the posted video abstracts to learn about the research.
2. Complete the Abstract Recording Review form provided.
  - Score each presentation using a rating scale of 1-5 (1 low, 5 high) on scientific merit, clinical outcomes, innovation or originality, and the quality of the discussion on the subject.
  - Include feedback – reinforcing or corrective – specific to the presenter's communication skills.
